Letter from our Prayer Co ordinator



As I sit here, a song of deep gratitude fills my heart—"Look what the Lord has done!" Perhaps it's the season—nestled between Canadian and U.S. Thanksgiving, or just after the Jewish Feast of Tabernacles—but my heart is overflowing with joy and a desire to shout His praises from the rooftops. Two years ago, I was "hijacked" by God to join 24-7 Prayer South Africa alongside Nkosinathi. At that time, Nathi had been faithfully walking, trusting, and waiting—building

relationships and sharing the vision of Prayer - Mission - Justice in Cape Town.

We started by praying and dreaming, asking God what He wanted to do with 24-7 Prayer SA. One year later, we found ourselves at the International Gathering in Rotterdam with what felt like a gang! Now, we were six team members across four provinces, and a National Gathering stirring in our hearts. As we prepare to attend this year's International Gathering in Stuttgart, we pause to reflect on how far God has brought us in another year—and all that He has done.

We've hosted the first National Gathering on African soil. We have a growing team and momentum that's hard to keep up with! What excites me most is seeing us move outward: as we breathe in through prayer, we breathe out into mission and justice.

Just this month alone, our weekly meetings have been filled with awe-inspiring highlights we couldn't have imagined:

- A powerful time of equipping and igniting our Anglican brothers and sisters in prayer at their Annual Conference in KZN.
- A week of missions in the Eastern Cape with the Magana's, where we learned of unreached people groups in remote Transkei villages.
- A new group joining Nathi in Stuttgart, Germany.
- Prayer rooms filling up—spaces where God is healing, bringing freedom, and meeting people deeply.



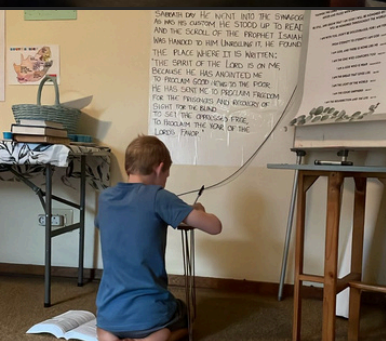
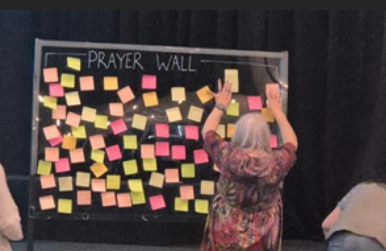
LIVE PRAYER ROOMS AND GROWTH IN 2025

Andile reminded me today of the prophetic image shared at our National Gathering in March: 24-7 Prayer South Africa as a needle and thread. We see this as our role—deep connectors, stitching communities and churches together. Not superficially, but deeply. A piercing needle, leaving lasting evidence of connection even if the fabric is pulled apart. Much of what we do is unseen, like the hidden stitches in a garment. Not flashy, but vital. And because of this hiddenness, fundraising can be difficult. After all, prayer is free, right?

But we trust that you, our partners, see the impact and want to join in with what God is doing—not just in South Africa, but across our continent.

We are so grateful for your support and prayers. They have truly carried us. Please don't stop.

If you're not already giving financially, would you prayerfully consider it? We are not supported by International and rely on self-funding. Regular giving—even small amounts—helps us cover fuel for mission trips, printing costs, and prayer room materials. All of it goes toward igniting prayer across cities and rural outposts.

We're even trusting God for a 4x4 vehicle to reach those unreached villages in the Transkei. What an exciting thought! And we want to support our growing team, who give so generously of their time and resources.

Whether you partner with us through prayer, time, or finances, I hope this newsletter and the attached report deeply encourage you. May you be spurred on to keep going, to hope with abandon, and to pray with boldness and confidence—trusting to see revival in your time.

May you be excited to offer your few fishes and loaves, and watch Him do miracles. Humbled to be used by Him. Honored to witness His work.

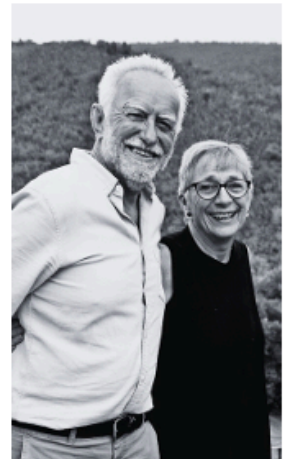
