


FOUR STRATEGIC PILLARS

We serve the Church by forming disciples in prayer and catalysing communities to pray, go, and act for justice so that Jesus is known, the Church and society are reconciled and renewed.




2025: A Year Marked by God's Movement

"Look what the Lord has done."

2025 was a year in which we witnessed God moving across South Africa in ways that left us humbled, grateful, and filled with expectant hope for the future. From prayer rooms multiplying across provinces, to our first-ever National Gathering on African soil, to mission partnerships taking root in the Eastern Cape and KZN—this year has been a tangible reminder of God's faithfulness and the quiet, steady work of His Spirit in our nation.

What began as a simple "yes" to prayer in 2017 has now grown into a nationwide movement marked by unity, hunger, and obedience. We have seen churches, schools, youth movements, justice ministries, and entire communities return to the place of prayer—discovering once again that all mission flows from the presence of Jesus.

This year, God expanded our team from 7 to 11 staff and key volunteers, now active across five provinces, with new regional networks emerging across the country. Our belief that "ministry moves at the rate of relationship" proved true again and again as God brought extraordinary people alongside us—leaders, intercessors, partners, pastors, and young pioneers ready to carry the flame of prayer into their regions.

IGNITING PRAYER

In 2025, prayer rooms multiplied across South Africa as churches, schools and communities responded to God's invitation to "Return & Rest". During the Global Week of 24-7 Prayer, 104 prayer rooms in 6 provinces prayed continuously for 17,472 hours in one week.

Many Churches were inspired in this time to make a permanent prayer room and have not stopped praying since.

Our vision is to keep igniting places of day-and-night prayer, especially in provinces that are still waiting for their first prayer room and we aim to see all 9 provinces covered in 2026.

EQUIPPING & RESOURCING

In 2025 we offered 4 youth training opportunities and launched prayer schools, retreats and online resources that are shaping a new generation of praying leaders.

2025 IN NUMBERS

Our digital reach grew beyond anything we anticipated:
